Derived largely from lectures delivered by Abdy at the University of Cambridge, *A Historical Sketch of Civil Procedure Among the Romans* discusses the historical features of civil procedure in Rome, tracing its progress from the ancient Twelve Tables (450 BCE) through the complex Imperial Code, which was implemented in 284 CE.

The author also delves into the separation of the legislative and judicial functions of the chief magistrates at Rome, the position of the *Judex* (the Judge), the influence of equitable remedies on the *Jus civile*, the history of Interdicts, and the change in the character and process of Appeals.

Written at a time when English law was being shaped by the principles and merits of classic Roman law, *A Historical Sketch of Civil Procedure Among the Romans* significantly aided legal researchers of that day, and its demand for proper codification and improved legal education still hold great meaning for today's legal scholars.
