The celebrated *Frank G. Raichle Lecture Series on Law in American Society* contains 18 lectures delivered at Canisius College by some of the **most prominent** legal dignitaries, including former Chief Justice William H. **Rehnquist**, former U.S. Attorney General Janet **Reno**, the Honorable Robert H. **Bork**, and many other important figures from the legal community.

The lectures began in 1981 and have focused on a wide range of topics, all dealing with problems arising out of the way the legal system operates in America. While some of the speakers have delivered addresses that were academic in style and content, others have used the platform to raise controversial issues and present their views on the day's most pressing legal matters.



## ***About Frank G. Raichle and the Pre-Law Center...***

In 1981, Canisius College established the Frank G. Raichle Pre-Law Center in honor of the man who was a leader of the American Bar for more than sixty years. During that time, he earned many awards and civic honors, including the Presidency of the American College of Trial Lawyers, and was closely associated with Canisius College throughout much of his career.

Mr. Raichle was named to the Board of Regents of Canisius College in 1961 by (Rev.) James J. McGinley, the College's President, and was then awarded the honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters at the College's 102<sup>nd</sup> commencement by new President (Rev.) James M. Demske, S.J. two years later.

The Board of Regents presented Mr. Raichle with its Distinguished Citizen's Achievement Award in 1979, and he was subsequently elected to a three-year term on the College's Board of Trustees, where he served as an active member of its Executive Committee and its Finance and Budget Committee until he passed away on January 24, 1986.

The purpose of the Raichle Center is to enhance the quality of the undergraduate experience of those Canisius College students who wish to attend law school and enter the legal profession. One of many activities sponsored by the Raichle Center is an annual lecture series, where distinguished members of the legal profession are invited to the campus to speak on problems of law and the American society.
