During his time as a professor at the University of Dublin, Dr. Francis Stoughton Sullivan delivered a series of 43 lectures to his students that served to connect England's history with its law. The addresses helped establish the English jurist as one of the pre-eminent minds on legal history, and his research into the nature and development of feudal laws was deemed "extensive and ingenious."

In order to preserve Dr. Sullivan's lectures after he passed away, they were compiled into a single volume entitled, *An Historical Treatise on the Feudal Law, and the Constitution and Laws of England*. After being out-of-print for more than two centuries, this classic work has now been reprinted by William S. Hein & Co., Inc.

The lectures are noted for their historical deductions and for covering a wide variety of topics, including the influence of the feudal system upon the modern law of tenures, the King's power, the share of the Commons in the Legislature, marriage, King John's dispute with the court of Rome, and the Magna Charta.

This excellent resource on the laws and customs of England was published around the same time as Sir William Blackstone's *Commentaries on the Laws of England* (also available from Hein – see over) and was held in similarly high regard by its peers. *An Historical Treatise on the Feudal Law, and the Constitution and Laws of England* remains an indispensable source on the development of English law and is an important addition to any library's legal history collection.
