The Ames Foundation was founded in 1910 with contributions from the friends of the late James Barr Ames of Harvard Law School "for the purpose of continuing the advancement of legal knowledge and aiding the improvement of the law." The Foundation was organized as a charitable corporation under the laws of Massachusetts, and the directors of the Foundation determined to devote the efforts of the Foundation to publications in legal history.

A Brief History of the Ames Foundation

The publications of the Foundation reflect the continuing interest of members of the faculty of the Harvard Law School in English legal history. Professor John Henry Beale edited one of the two earliest volumes and inspired the other. The publications from 1929 to 1938 reflected the period in which T.F.T. Plucknett taught English legal history at the school. The more recent publications are the result of the stimulus given to the English legal history department at Harvard by the late Professor Samuel E. Thorne, who was, in turn, succeeded by the undersigned.

From its beginning, the Ames Foundation has focused on the publication of the Year Books of Richard II (1377-1399), the only Year Book series that remained entirely unprinted. The series covers all those years for which known manuscripts survive. The "regular" (i.e., non-Year Book) series includes two bibliographical works, an edition of records of justices of the peace (14th and 15th centuries), and a late thirteenth-century treatise on mercantile law.
