With the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) questions arose regarding the Act's importance in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. The APA is a critical source of authority within federal American administrative law, applying to both independent agencies and executive department agencies and their subdivisions.

The Attorney General's Manual on the Administrative Procedure Act (1947) lists four basic purposes of the APA. The Act requires agencies to keep the public informed of their organization, procedures and rules; provides for public participation in the rule-making process; establishes uniform standards for the conduct of formal rule-making and adjudication; and defines the scope of judicial review.
