With the 60th anniversary of the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) questions arose regarding the Act's importance in the 21st Century. The APA is a critical source of authority within federal American administrative law, applying to both independent agencies and executive department agencies and their subdivisions.

The *Attorney General's Manual on the Administrative Procedure Act* (1947) lists four basic purposes of the APA. The Act requires agencies to keep the public informed of their organization, procedures and rules; provides for public participation in the rule-making process; establishes uniform standards for the conduct of formal rule-making and adjudication; and defines the scope of judicial review.
