

This volume was the last published work of the distinguished author, philosopher and statesman, James Bryce. The work contains the eight lectures delivered by him before the Institute of Politics at Williamstown, Mass. in the summer of 1921. In the preface, Bryce said the work was intended to answer the questions centering on the growing international unrest.

"While economic relations between nations have been growing closer, and the personal intercourse between their members far more frequent, political friendliness between states has not increased. Why is it that before the clouds of the Great War have vanished from the sky new clouds are rising over the horizon? What can be done to avert the dangers that are threatening the peace of mankind?" -Preface

In the first two lectures, Bryce gives the readers the history of international relations from the time of Plato, to Pope Alexander VI, to Napoleon and Bismarck. The third and fourth lectures consider the motives which influence the conduct of states and lead to peace or war, such as economics and nationalism. The fifth and sixth lectures deal with the methods of international negotiations and include the practices of diplomacy and the development of international laws. In the final two lectures Bryce includes direct methods for averting war, like conferences, mediation, and arbitration.
