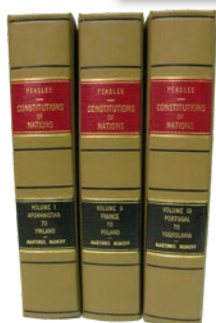

Constitutions of Nations, First Edition



Published in 1950, the first edition of Peaslee’s *Constitutions of Nations* was the first-ever compilation of all the national constitutions of the world published in English. Arranged alphabetically by country, this three-volume set includes the seals or coat of arms and a summary description and bibliography for each of the 83 nations featured. The summary details each nation’s international status, form of government, source of sovereign power, rights of the people, executive, judicial, and legislative branches of government, area, population and language.

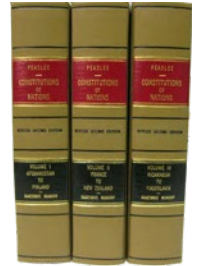

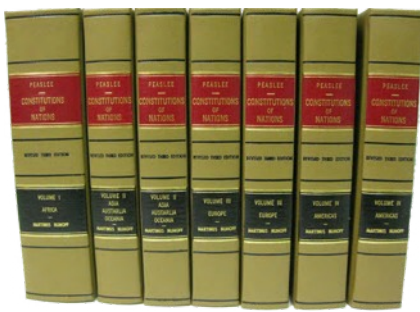

Constitutions of Nations, Second Edition

Published six years after the original, this second edition, in three volumes, reflects major changes that occurred in the texts or status of the constitutions of 35 of the 89 nations featured in the first edition. Five new countries, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Libya, and Viet Nam, became recognizable as sovereign nations since the first edition was published and are, therefore, included in this second edition. Other changes to this edition include improvements in translations and summaries, revisions of tables, and additions to bibliographies.



Constitutions of Nations, Third Edition



This third edition, taking on a new form, is published in separate volumes by continent, rather than by alphabetically country. Volume One covers African countries and includes the constitutions of 36 nations, of which only four (Ethiopia, Liberia, Libya, and South Africa) appeared in the second edition. The constitutions in this volume were revised through September 1, 1964.

Volume Two, *Asia, Australia, and Oceania*, contains the constitutions of 36 nations, including entries for five new nations, Kuwait, Maldive Republic, Malaysia, Singapore and Western Samoa. Another five nations had entries in the previous edition but no texts. Constitutions are included for nine new countries, and amended constitutions are available for twelve. The texts in this volume were revised through September 1, 1965.

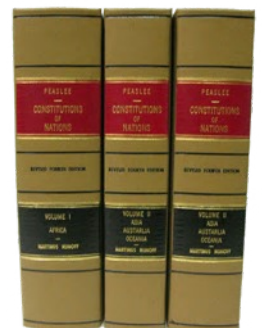
Volume Three contains the constitutions of 35 European nations. The constitutions for Cyprus and Malta are new to this edition. Six countries, Czechoslovakia, France, Monaco, Rumania, San Marino, and Yugoslavia, have new constitutions, while another twenty have been amended. Only four countries reflect no change since the second edition. Texts in this fourth volume cover through November 15, 1966.

Volume Four covers 26 nations of the Americas. Barbados, Guyana, Jamaica, and Trinidad & Tobago are new entries. Thirteen nations have new constitutions represented in this volume, and all of the remaining constitutions have been amended. Texts in this volume were revised through September 1, 1968.

Constitutions of Nations, Fourth Edition

The revised fourth edition, published in 1974, begins with the volume containing the African constitutions. When the first volume of the third edition was published in 1964, the independence of the new African nations was quite recent and changes to the constitutional structure were inevitable. This edition takes into account those changes. Volume One now contains entries for 43 countries. New countries to this edition include Botswana, Gambia, Mauritius, and Swaziland. The independence of Guinea-Bissau, recognized by the United Nations in October 1973, came too late for an entry to be included in this volume.

Only six countries had no change in their constitutional structure: Ethiopia, Guinea, Ivory Coast, Liberia, Mauritania, and Niger. In addition, the constitution for Rwanda was unchanged but was suspended while this volume was at press. Apart from entirely new entries, there are new constitutions for twelve countries. Eight constitutions have been amended and the constitutions for nine countries have been suspended.
