

LEGISLATIVE CHRONOLOGY

May 7, 1996

H.R. 3396 introduced in House by Rep. Bob Barr.

May 8, 1996

H.R. 3396 referred to Subcommittee on the Constitution of the House Judiciary Committee.

May 8, 1996

S. 1740 introduced by Sen. Don Nickles; referred to Senate Judiciary Committee.

May 15, 1996

Subcommittee hearing held on H.R. 3396.

June 12, 1996

H.R. 3396 ordered to be reported (20–10).

July 9, 1996

H.R. 3396 reported by the House Judiciary Committee (H. Rep. No. 104-664).

July 11, 1996

Hearings held on S. 1740 by Senate Judiciary Committee.

July 12, 1996

H.R. 3396 passed by House (342–67).

July 29, 1996

S. 1999 introduced by Sen. Don Nickles; referred to Senate Judiciary Committee.

September 10, 1996

H.R. 3396 passed by Senate (85–14); cleared for White House.

September 20, 1996

H.R. 3396 presented to President Clinton.

September 21, 1996

H.R. 3396 signed by President Clinton; became Public Law No. 104-199.
